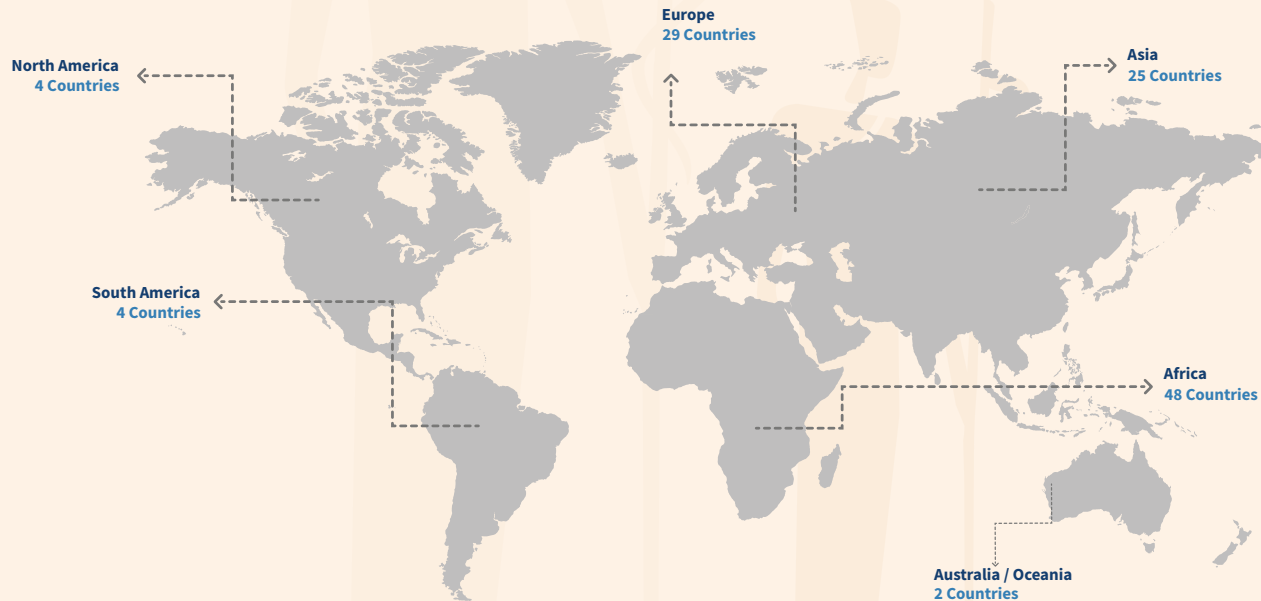
PRESIDENT OF THE ARAB REPUBLIC OF EGYPT INAUGURATES
THE FIRST EDITION OF AFRICA HEALTH EXCON

Under the auspices of H.E. the president of Egypt Abdel El fattah El-Sisi, the second edition of Africa Health ExCon continues to build upon the various outcomes of the first edition through Africa's sustainable platform, towards building a sustainable and advanced healthcare sector.



Africa Health ExCon hosted its 2nd edition from 6-9 June 2023 at Egypt International Exhibition Centre (EIEC) Cairo, Egypt. The event brought together 39,964 healthcare and trade professionals from 113 countries.

A platform that promotes health technology & innovation, building capacities, and encourages collaboration and health trade in Africa, more than 300 exhibitors displayed their health technology products and innovations, 23 sponsors, 5 pavilions, 15 international partners in a varying degrees of health sectors: Pharmaceuticals & API's, Medical Devices & Consumables, Diagnostic Equipment, Devices & Consumables, Medical Equipment, Digital solutions, Healthcare Providers, Dental Equipment & Consumables.

On top of that, 28 scientific conferences, 26 workshops, 316 sessions and numerous accredited CME by Royal College of Surgeons and American Association For Continuous Medical Education were held at Africa Health ExCon 2023 with the presence of 1547 speakers.

- A memorandum of understanding between the Egyptian Authority for Unified Procurement and Viatres Egypt for training and continuing medical education for workers in the health sector.
- A cooperation protocol between the Public Authority for Health Care and Viatres Pharmaceutical Company for training and continuing medical education for medical staff.
- Memorandum of Understanding between Boehringer Ingelheim and Roche to improve health care for patients with heart failure in Egypt.



- A joint cooperation protocol between the Ministry of Health, the Comprehensive Health Insurance, the General Authority for Health Accreditation and Control, and iHealth to expand the network of service providers for comprehensive health insurance beneficiaries
- A cooperation agreement between Roche Egypt and Alameda Hospitals Group.
- A cooperation protocol between the General Authority for Health Care and the Federation of Arab Hospitals to promote a sustainable green transformation of health care.
- A cooperation protocol between the Public Authority for Health Care and AstraZeneca to detect chronic kidney disease.
- A cooperation protocol between the Public Authority for Health Care and Sanofi to provide remote medical consultations for patients with atopic eczema.
